Annual tuition & advising:

\$39,750 (Fall 2026 intake, up to 54 quarter credits)

Housing:

\$21,430 (Fall 2026 intake, shared, twin room)*

Guardianship:

\$3,500 per year, pro-rated upon turning 18 (required for students under age 18)

* Fall 2026 through Spring 2027. Students may also stay during the summer if they are enrolled in credit-bearing on-campus courses. Single rooms can be arranged subject to availability for an extra fee.
